PURPOSE: Lead a quality music program for children and youth that will nurture their faith formation

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Lead and direct a choir program for Grades K-2 and Grades 3-6, which may be enhanced by a musical, movement, games, and various instrumental activities
- Re-energize and lead a music program for Grades 7-12 in coordination with the Youth Ministry Leadership
- Recruit and train choir members and encourage their attendance and participation in all music activities
- Give children the opportunity to participate in worship services through music on a regular basis including preparation and rehearsals
- Encourage parental involvement including regular contact with parents related to rehearsals, volunteer scheduling and assisting in worship
- Encourage the children to get to know one another in a caring atmosphere while bringing God's word to life through music
- Provide music leadership for Vacation Bible School

RELATIONSHIPS: Collaborate with Director of Music, Church Educator and Youth Ministry Leadership

REPORTS TO: Accountable to the Pastor as Head of Staff and to the Worship and Music Committee

QUALIFICATIONS (minimum): Bachelor's degree in music, two years' experience leading a church music program for children preferred; keyboard skills highly desired; capacity to celebrate and love children; ability to employ a variety of instructional techniques; ability to work gracefully with children, parents, and staff members
