**Children are welcome in worship.** You will find yellow worship bags for all children at the chapel entrance.

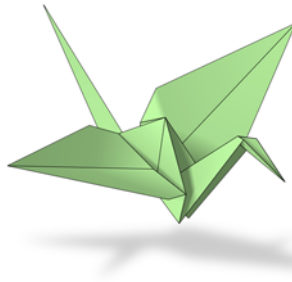
## What is Your Prayer for the World?
